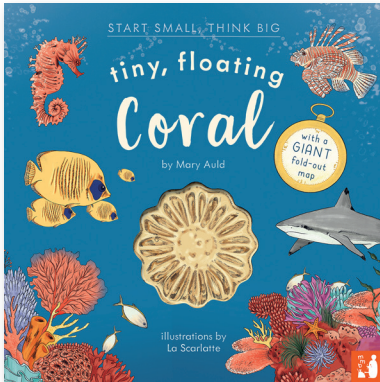

COLOURING THE REEF



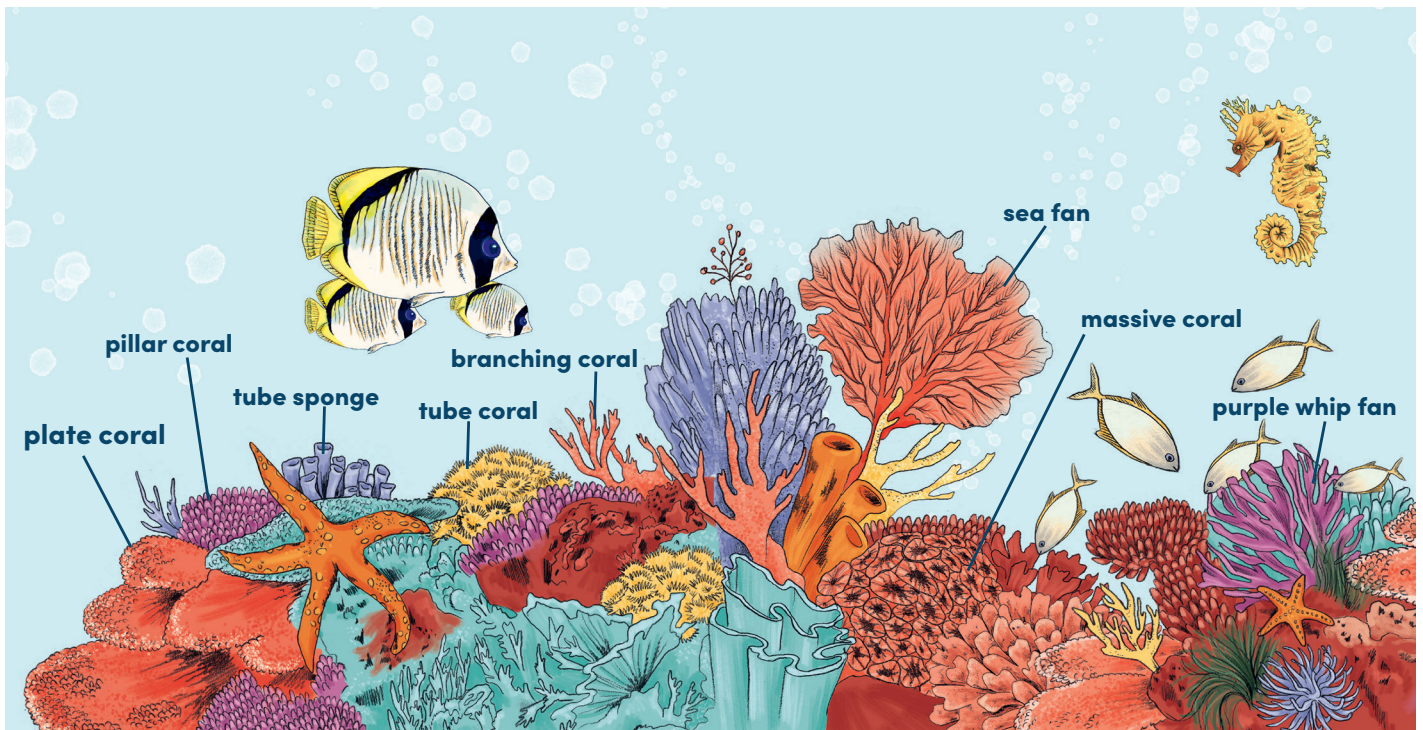

Lead-in activity

Tiny, Floating Coral introduces readers to the different types of coral. Read the story and linger over the reef spread that shows some of the different types of coral. Explain that hard corals build the reef by making coralite. Soft corals, such as fans and whips, have more flexible bodies that move in the water.

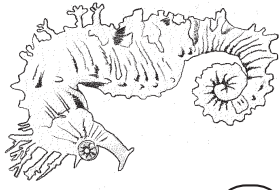
Main activity

Hand out the colouring-in sheets attached to colour in. Here is the illustrator's palette to find similar colours. Then ask the children to draw lines to label the different types of coral.

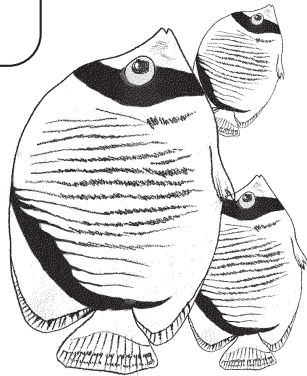

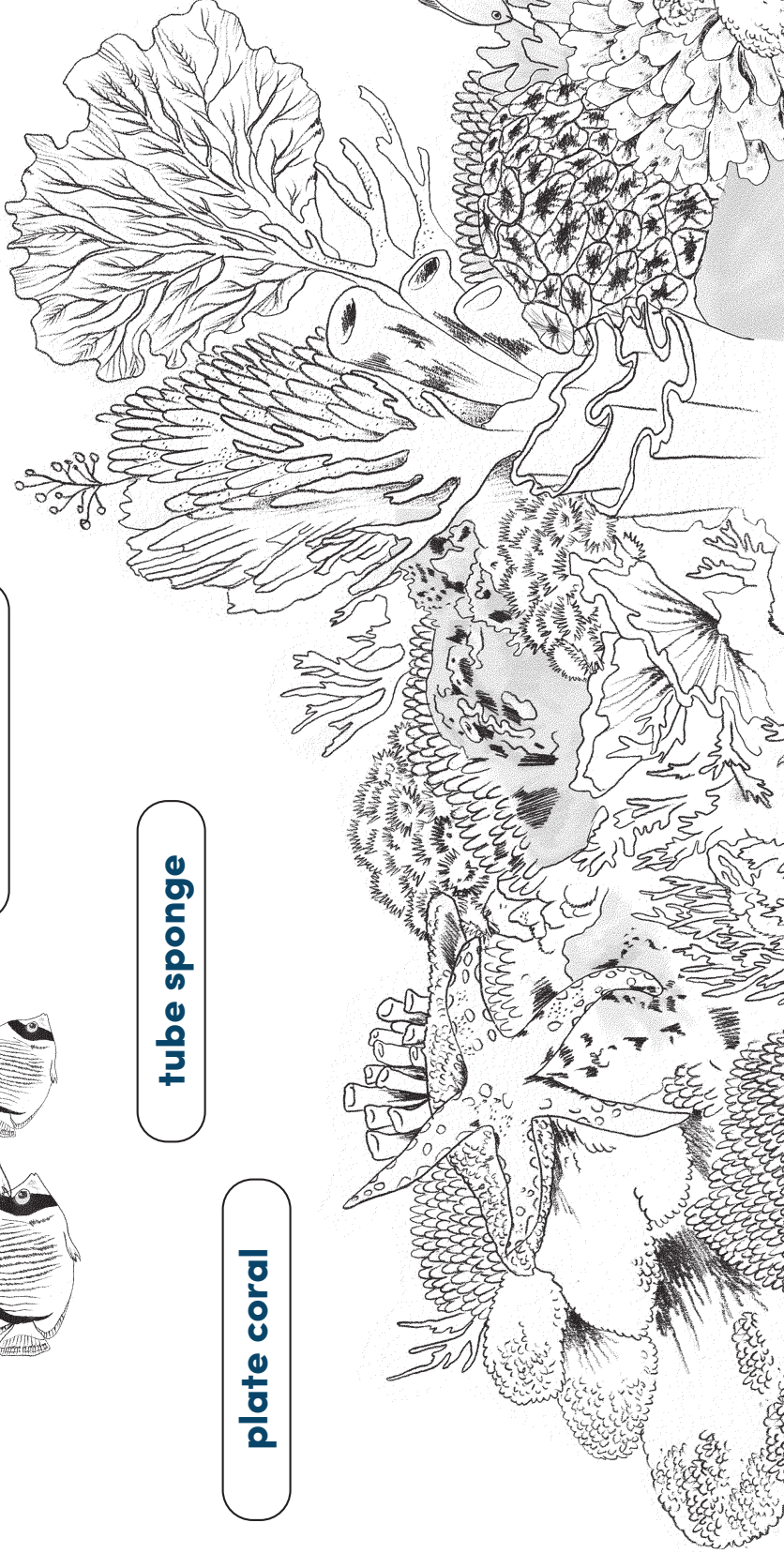


pillar coral
